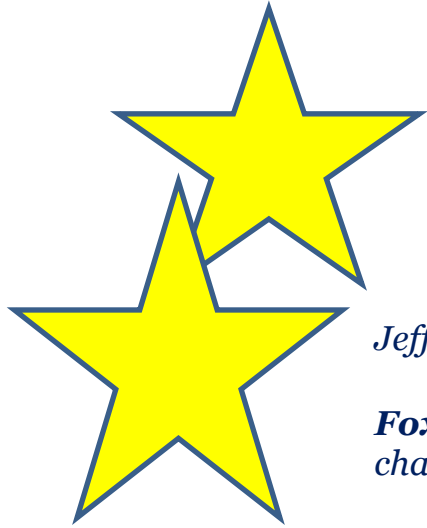

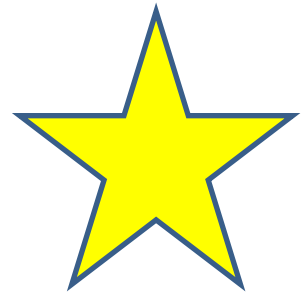
## Special Awards this week



**Hedgehog Class** – Mila – For working really hard on her writing

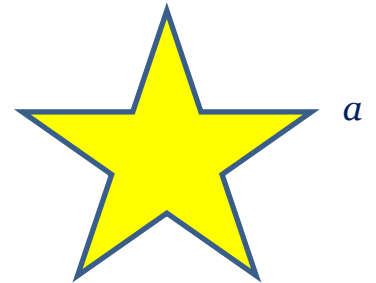
**Badger Class** – Jacob – For working hard in all group work tasks with Mrs Jeffries
