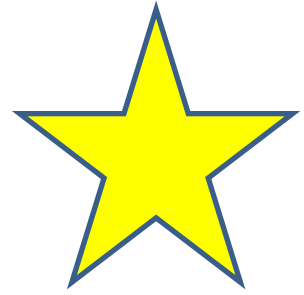

Hedgehog Class – Isabella for her super listening skills

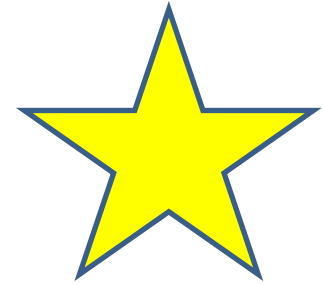
Badger Class – Tesa for working hard on fractions this week
