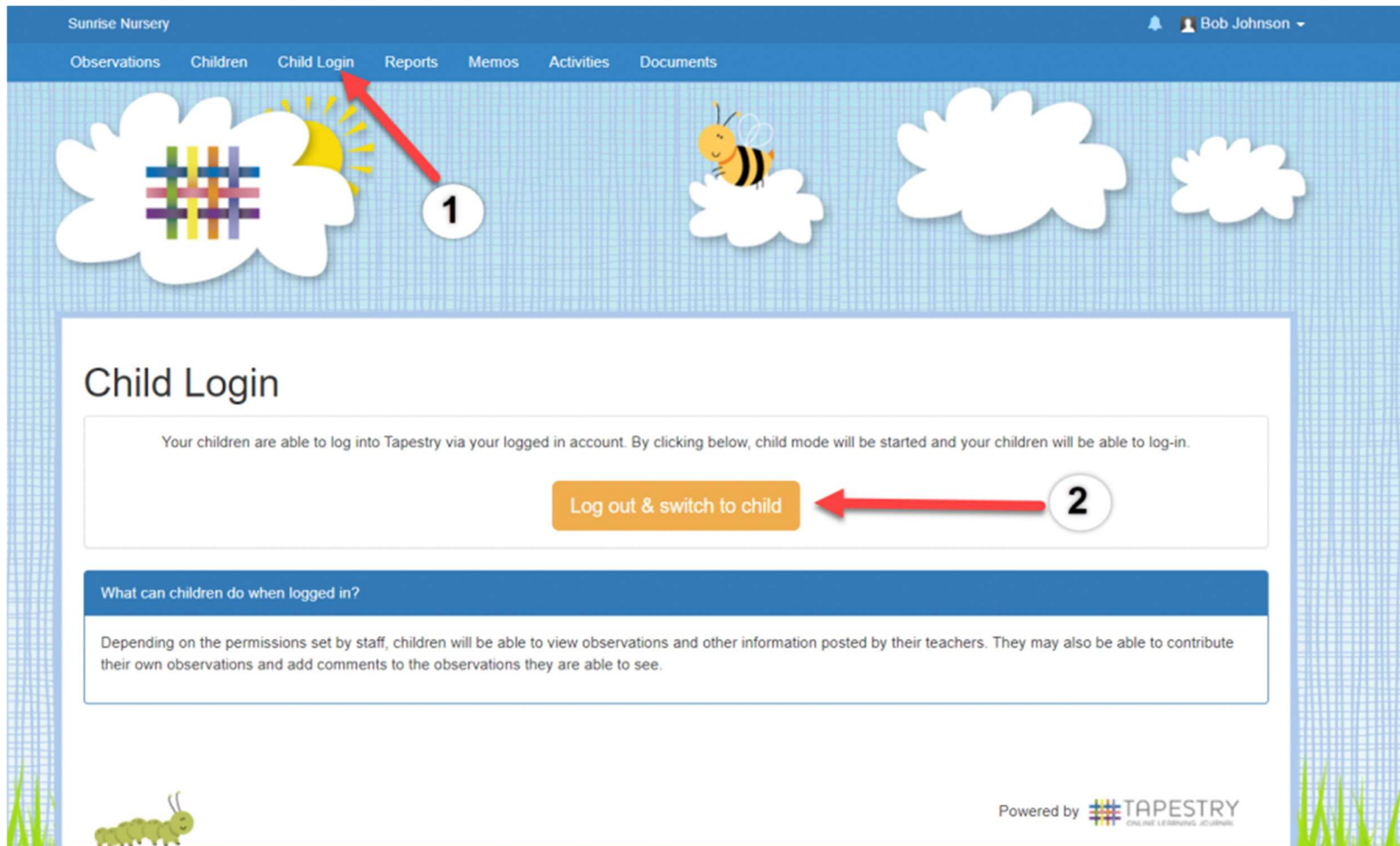


Tapestry – Child Login

The Child Login on Tapestry allows children to log into their own Tapestry account to view and respond to observations and activities set by their teachers.

To allow your child to log in at home, you will firstly need to log into your account from the *browser version of Tapestry* (tapestryjournal.com). Then click on the 'Child Login' (1) option on the blue bar at the top of the screen. On the next page, click on the 'Log out and switch to child' (2) button.
